What is Buprenorphine?

Buprenorphine (Suboxone®) is a medication to treat opioid use disorder. It promptly stops withdrawal symptoms and reduces opioid craving. It is longacting, has a very low overdose risk and minimal euphoric effect, and helps support recovery.

Did You Know?

- Use of Buprenorphine reduces risk of overdose death by 50% or more, and helps people stay in recovery.
- You can use buprenorphine as needed, but regular daily use will increase your ability to care for yourself and your loved ones, and to maintain your independence.

What can you expect?

AT YOUR FIRST VISIT:

- A Peer Recovery Coach will introduce you to the clinic and collect basic information.
- You will watch a short video, Designing Your Own Recovery.

AT EVERY VISIT:

- You will meet with a medical provider who will help you get the most out of the medication.
- In most cases, you will be provided a short-term supply of medication.
- You can meet with a peer recovery coach, or set a time to meet outside of clinic hours.

ON RETURN VISITS:

 Occasionally, urine testing will occur to confirm presence of buprenorphine.
